Selection Criteria for entrance into the Master of Pathology Programme

1. Possess a Medical Degree:

Hold an MD, MBBS, MBBCh, or an equivalent medical qualification.

2. Registration with the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC):

Must be registered with the MMC to practise medicine in Malaysia, in accordance with the Medical (Amendment) Act 2012 and the Medical Regulations 2017.

 Note: Non-Malaysian candidates are required to obtain a Temporary Practising Certificate from the MMC.

3. Fulfil Sponsoring Body Requirements:

Meet all eligibility requirements set by the sponsoring body, such as the Ministry of Health, universities, or other relevant institutions.

4. Clinical Experience:

Have at least three years of clinical experience after obtaining the basic medical degree, including:

- (a) Satisfactory completion of housemanship, and
- (b) At least one year of post-housemanship clinical experience.

5. Pass the Medical Specialist Pre-entrance Examination (MedEx):

Achieve at least the minimum score as determined by the respective Specialty Board.

6. Interview:

Successfully complete the interview process for the Master of Pathology (MPath) Programme in Malaysia.
