		B.4.5	Candidates will then be transferred by the examiner to the <b>Test Room 10 minutes</b> before the test begins. There will be <b>four</b> candidates in the test room. Candidates will be given <b>a briefing by the Examiner</b> .	
		B.4.6	Candidates MUST turn on their camera and microphone when in the test room.	
		B.4.7	The test is divided into <b>two</b> sections. The <b>first</b> section is an <b>individual presentation</b> . Each candidate is allocated <b>4 minutes</b> for this section, <b>2 minutes</b> are allocated for <b>preparation</b> (candidates may make notes on a paper provided by the candidate) while another <b>2 minutes</b> for the <b>individual presentation</b> .
