

FACTS ABOUT MUET on Demand (MoD)

What is MoD?

The MUET on Demand (MoD) is a method of implementation for Malaysian University English Test (MUET), a test which measures English language proficiency. MUET is aligned with Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) since 2021 and the MoD standard is equivalent with MUET.

Method of testing MoD ?

It is a Computer-Based Test (CBT) and Paper-Based Test (PBT) for written test components (Reading, Writing and Listening).

For the speaking test component, it is tested face-to-face or via online.

Who takes MoD?

Candidates who tend to pursue tertiary studies at universities in Malaysia or countries that acknowledge MUET. Other than that, MoD can be used for working purposes.

What conditions must be satisfied before one can sit for MoD?

No conditions are imposed on any candidate who is interested in taking MoD.

When is MoD administered?

MoD is offered on a monthly basis since June 2018. Candidates can obtain information on test dates via the Malaysian Examinations Council (MEC) portal <http://www.mpm.edu.my>. Agencies can request for MoD on specific dates - subject to approval of the MEC.

When to register for MoD?

Dates for registration will be advertised in the MEC portal and official media accounts.

How to register for MoD?

Registration for MoD can be made online through the MEC portal <http://www.mpm.edu.my>.

Candidates can check their registration status through the MEC portal. Candidates may print their MoD registration slip (MoD/D) from the MEC portal. Agencies can apply to register in bulk to the MEC.

How much is the test fee?

The test fee for Malaysian and Non-Malaysian candidates are as follows:

What are the skills tested in MoD?

MoD comprises four components: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing

The duration and weighting of each component are as follows:

Paper Code	Paper	Duration	Weighting
800/1	Listening	50 minutes	25%
800/2	Speaking	30 minutes	25%
800/3	Reading	75 minutes	25%
800/4	Writing	75 minutes	25%

How are MoD results reported?

MoD results are reported as follows:

Aggregated Score	Band	User
331-360 294-330	5+ 5.0	Proficient
258-293 211-257 164-210 123-163	4.5 4.0 3.5 3.0	Independent
82-122 36-81 1-35	2.5 2.0 1.0	Basic

How can MoD results be obtained?

MoD results will be available on the MEC portal within 14 working days.

Candidates will also receive their results from the MEC by post.

How long is the MoD result valid?

MoD results are valid for five years from the date of the MoD results.
