Selection criteria for entrance into the Master of Emergency Medicine programme

Below are the minimum requirements. Candidates must:

- 1. Possess a medical degree (MD, MBBS, MBBCh or equivalent medical qualification)
- 2. Be registered for medical practice by the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) under the Medical (Amendment) Act 2012 and Medical Regulations 2017.
 - Non-Malaysian candidates must obtain a Temporary Practicing Certificate from MMC.
- 3. Fulfil the criteria set by their sponsoring body eg Ministry of Health, Universities etc
- 4. Achieve an acceptable level of English proficiency as defined by each university
- 5. Undergo 3 components of assessments.
 - A. Component A (40%)
 - MedEx
 - B. Component B (30%)
 - Clinical service 5%
 - i. Repeat attempt in interview 3%
 - ii. Clinical services in Sabah/Sarawak 2%
 - Clinical experience in emergency medicine 5%
 - Academic achievements 18%
 - i. Organizing committee for conferences/ workshops and other related activities 5%
 - ii. Scholarly activities 10%
 - Poster presentation, oral presentation, publication (main author, corresponding author), manuscript, scientific article, chapter in scientific book, scientific book
 - iii. Other recognized activities with certification eg FRCEM, MRCEM, ACLS/ALS, ATLS/TLS, PALS/APLS, PHC, Disaster, Ultrasound, Airway, Dengue 3%
 - Co-curriculum 2% involvement in sports, cultural and social activities
 - C. Component C (30%)
 - Oral presentation and Interview
